Funded by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA), the Workforce Development Boards assist adult job seekers at the America's Job Centers of California (AJCC), helping them improve their interview skills and resume writing, and providing opportunities for job seekers to attend vocational training to help guarantee they find employment.

In order for WIOA to fund the training, the training provider must be on the Eligible Training Provider List (ETPL). So, how does the ETPL work? What happens once a college's program is on the ETPL? What about the payment structure?

Staff of the Workforce Development Boards from San Bernardino and Riverside Counties will present about the ETPL and walk participants through what to do once courses/programs are on the ETPL and how to make the most out of community college partnership with the AJCC.
