Discussion Items

Regional Dual Enrollment - Joyce opened the topic of a Regional Dual Enrollment Summit for consideration by the deans. Is there interest in this regionally? If interested, what might the summit look like? Perhaps develop a subcommittee to put it together. The purpose of the Summit would be to begin a regional dialogue around dual enrollment. Present best practices, and discuss successful models and how challenges have been addressed. Captured where each college is related to concurrent enrollment (C) and dual enrollment (D) above next to each person present. MSJC has dual in all 8 of their high school districts (20 high schools in all) with thousands of students enrolled. COD is currently piloting one class. Their college president has stated that WILL be pursuing dual enrollment college wide and they are currently in the “collegial discussion” phase. MSJC faculty co-lead their college dual enrollment advisory group. Faculty definitely need to lead some of the breakout/topics during the summit. Attendees should include: senate representatives (at a minimum a senate executive committee rep); counseling department chair/representative, admissions & records dean/director; CIOs and academic deans, other key student service representatives. Joyce will present this concept to her advisory group and will report back.

Regional Two Year Program Review Process - Julie opened the topic of a potential template and process for 2-year program review. Group approved the suggestion to move forward with a draft of a template and timeline for external reporting for 2-year program review. Julie will draft for next meeting.
