PROGRAM PROPOSALS – FIRST READ

- San Bernardino Valley College
Computer Network Support Specialist, Certificate (22 units)
Recommend approving this certificate for first read. MSC Kersey/Avila.
Discussion: Answered questions that were posed at the last meeting when action on this item was tabled. The faculty member, Roger Powell, was in attendance and indicated that a substantial number of courses in the certificate are part of the CISCO Academy program. It is essentially aligned with A+ certification. Prepares students to work in entry-level positions as a computer network support technicians and the program name is aligned with the SOC description. At this time they will only be pursuing a certificate of achievement, not a degree. May consider re-applying for a degree at a later date.
- San Bernardino Valley College
Refrigeration Service Engineer Society Certificate (35 units)
Recommend tabling this agenda item until such time as local LMI data can be reviewed. MSC Kersey/Avila
Discussion: Faculty Roberts and Halabi were on hand to answer questions. This is an advanced level required by industry and is a refresher for people already working in the field. Developed in partnership with Mt. SAC with 40% CTE Enhancement funding. It is not being offered by other colleges in the region and is strongly supported by industry.
